A Strategic View

- Executive communication empowers action
- Leveraging scarce resources for fiscal responsibility and maximum impact







Understanding Exposure Management

A Tactical View

- Exposure management isn't always one thing
- Exposure management is finding the best solution or the best combination of actions to remove/mitigate/remediate
- Exposure management is always looking at the big picture







The Intersection of Exposure Management & Security Operations

Strategies to Avoid Material Impact

Problem

- Security operations tend to be fairly reactive: we identify, then we fix.
- We don't always have good context for how valuable an asset is or how vulnerable it might be.

Solution

The value of exposure management is that you can be more proactive.

You can start identifying potential exposures before they become a problem and kill them before they ever have a chance to surface.







The Goal

Information and Wisdom

Transition from data to information and from knowledge to wisdom.

The board of directors and management care about information and wisdom.

Create context from a large volume of data and translate it into language that reflects how the company does business and makes money.






Practical Steps to Implement Continuous Threat Exposure Management (CTEM)
